

# R04: Registered Drug Users

## Purpose of collecting these data:

This module aims to collect information on trends in drug use which came to the attention of authorities through registration systems. While this information does not describe the entire population of drug users, it can be used to estimate drug use prevalence using indirect estimation techniques. Trends over time of registered drug users can also provide information on the changing nature of drug use.
